REQUEST FOR CONSENT TO HOLD YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Seaton youth group is run by Re:store and there will be a charge of £1 per session so we feel this will add value for our young people and enable us to put that money back in to providing for them for future sessions.

The youth group will be hosted by Pitchside at Seaton Town Football Club on the 1st and 3rd Mondays of the month from 6.30-8pm. Our staff and volunteers are only responsible for the young people between these times while they are in the building, please arrange drop off and collection around these times. Young people under the age of 13 will need parental consent to leave at the end of the session if leaving independently, those over the age of 13 will be free to go at 8pm.

We will endeavour to keep running throughout the year as well as within holidays but as our service will be heavily supported by volunteers, there may be occasions where we are unable to run if we don't have enough volunteers, as much notice as possible will be provided should that be the case.

For young people to be able to access our group we need to have consent and emergency contact details on file, unfortunately without this, we may have to turn people away. Please also make us aware of any allergies, behavioural or medical conditions that we need to know about.

All of this information will be stored securely as previously stated in our data consent policy.

We operate an open door policy and strive to be inclusive but ask that you make us aware of any additional needs we may need to make reasonable adjustments for. **We are only responsible for young people while they are in the building between the times of 6.30-8pm.** Those over the age of 13 will be allowed to leave at this time unless you have requested otherwise.
